

Juvenile Diversion Program

The purpose of Diversion is to recognize that juveniles can make inappropriate decisions regarding their behaviors. Through this program, they are being given the opportunity to be accountable for their offense(s), as well as to learn how to make more appropriate decisions in the future.

After all the program requirements are met, the charge against the juvenile will be dismissed and there will be no Court record of the offense.

Failure to cooperate or complete the program requirements will result in a failed Diversion, which means the petition will be returned to the County Attorney's Office and it will be scheduled for a formal Court hearing.
