## Juvenile Education Shoplifting Program

## Who participates in the Juvenile Education Shoplifting Program?

The Juvenile Education Shoplifting (JES) Program is designed for youth on diversion or probation who have committed a shoplifting offense in order to come into contact with the juvenile justice system.

### Program Goals

The Isanti County Probation JES Program goal is to help our youth understand how to make the choice not to shoplift, and to understand the consequences that come from making the choice to shoplift.

### Program Components

- 2-8 Diversion or court-ordered juveniles
- Group and individual sharing exercises
- Educational shoplifting video and shoplifting facts

## Cost

The cost of the one night 2-hour program is \$25.

Program fee must be paid upon arrival at the class, before the youth is permitted to participate. See back page for payment options
